We allow extra time to go out of our way for the convenience of our passengers

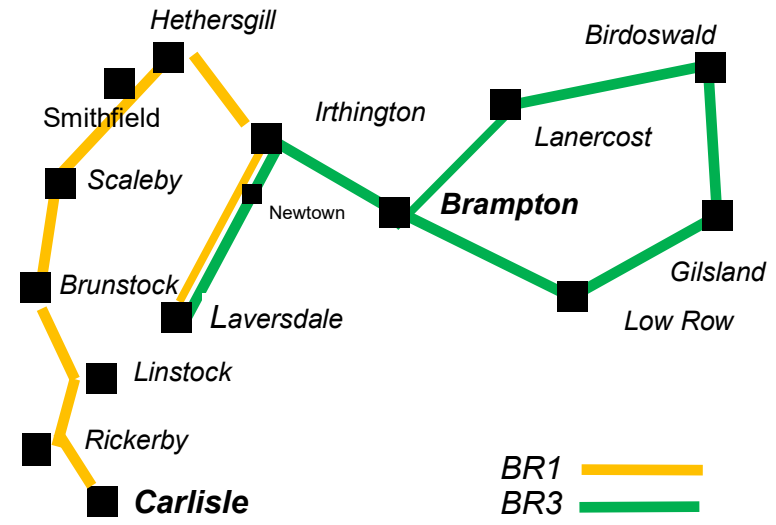
